



COVID-19 Car collections



1 Locate a COVID car collection centre

When you receive a pathology request form (printed or electronic) from your doctor for a COVID-19 test, locate a COVID-19 collection centre at <https://www.snp.com.au/our-locations/?P=65>. There are more than 80 you can attend, and car collections are performed at some. To find your nearest COVID car collection location, see <https://www.snp.com.au/our-locations/?P=3>.



2 Arriving for your COVID car collection

When you arrive at the car collection location, park your car and do not leave your car.



3 Contacting the collector

Call the mobile number for the COVID car collection centre. They will need to know the make of your car, the licence plate and how many people are having samples collected. Place your request form(s) under your front windscreen wiper and wait for the collector.



4 Collecting your sample

Stay in your car and have your request form and Medicare card ready. Our collector will check your details and collect your sample.



5 Leaving the centre

Once your sample is collected you are able to leave. Please follow the instructions from your doctor, particularly about self-isolating requirements.



6 Results

Your results will be sent to your doctor, usually within 48-72 hours.



NEGATIVE

If your result is negative, we will also send you an SMS with further instructions.



POSITIVE

If the result is positive, you will be notified by your doctor.
